OUR GUIDE TO THE BEST BARS IN THE ALPS

1 SCHNEGGAREI, LECH

Schneggarei is a wooden lodge sat at the bottom of the main run into Lech, with a big thing for cow-print. But this is not just any old-fashioned Austrian bar. Drinking in Schneggarei is much more than just Jagermeister (although, along with lots of flavoured Stolichnaya, there's plenty of that when you need it), and eating is more than just tiroler grostl, with large hearty salads and pizzas more than capable of fuelling you for a day on the slopes. Come the evening, dancers in ski boots mix happily with a more stylish crowd, and the relaxed blend of eating, drinking and the occasional live band gives this place a chilled yet lively atmosphere.

2 BAR ROMA, COURMAYEUR

In this beautiful little Italian village nestle some of the best kept nightlife secrets in the Alpine community. The narrow cobbled streets of this delightful little corner of the world wind their way to some wonderful drinking delights. The main après takes place in the shape of a laid-back, old world bar – Bar Roma. Imagine a roaring log fire, a promisingly long bar with comfy, antique sofas, where bar snacks are served for free, dancing till late takes place in a sweaty little downstairs cavern and the revelling spills out onto the street. Ah, heaven...

3 LE WHITE PUB, FLAINE

Le White Pub is the busiest bar in the Forum part of Flaine village and often hosts busy nights into the early hours of the morning. It's an Irish-style pub with food served early in the evening and après-ski happy hours. The nachos are pretty good for a carb-loading session, and they have some interesting cocktails and shooters on the menu if you're feeling brave enough. The clientele is a mixture of locals and tourists which makes for a good atmosphere, and they show skiing and boarding films all night long if you're bored of your mates. There isn't really a dance floor in the pub but that's not to say the odd move or two isn't thrown next to the bar.

4 VILLA CRAZY DAISY, ZELL AM SEE

Affectionately known as Crazy Daisy's, it's one of the busiest bars in Zell and is also a great lunchtime spot with views of the lake from a perfect sun terrace (if you're lucky with the weather). In the evening there's a restaurant plus a cocktail bar and the main bar on the first floor. Dancing is compulsory and live music kicks off the action most nights. You'll find it hard not to enjoy this modern bar – especially if you love straightforward ski resort partying.
